For the academic year 2010/2011 the following specializations are listed:

- **Interpretation and Theory of Interpretation in English** (Piano, Organ, Harpsichord, Violin, Viola, Violoncello, Double Bass, Flute, Clarinet, French Horn, Trombone, Percussion, Guitar)
- **Interpretation and Theory of Interpretation in German** (Choral Conducting, Orchestral Conducting, Opera Direction, Singing, Piano, Organ, Harpsichord, Violin, Viola, Violoncello, Double Bass, Oboe, Bassoon, French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Percussion, Guitar)
- **Composition and Theory of Composition in English or German language.**

2. The attachment of the application is the art curriculum and copies of documents of master degree graduation, i.e. Diploma and the Diploma Supplement. Other attachment is the thesis proposal in the range of 2 to 4 pages which should be also sent on the e-mail address: jarosova@jamu.cz

The fee for admission process is CZK 530 if you apply by electronic application, or CZK 588 if you apply in writing. The fee should be paid by bank transfer. Please, indicate in the box "message to the recipient" your personal identification number/date of birth.
