3 – 8 September 2007 Concert Hall, Faculty of Music of JAMU, Brno Besední dům, Brno

- O1. The international competition is announced for violin. The applicants cannot exceed 25 years of age on the opening day of the competition.
- O2. The competition consists of three rounds. The third round will be held in cooperation with an orchestra.
- 03. Competition performances are public.
- 04. The competition repertoire
 - Round I a) own choice from capricios by N. Paganini
 - b) own choice from a part of a solo sonata or a partita by J. S. Bach

Maximum lenght of performance is 20 minutes. Performance by heart is required.

Round II a) Leoš Janáček: Sonata for Violin and Piano*

- b) Eugène Ysaÿe: one sonata; own choice from 6 solo sonatas
- c) One composition from any style period, own choice

The choice must not include any composition performed in the first round.

Maximum lenght of performance is 45 minutes. Performance by heart is not required.

Round III One violin concert with an orchestra; own choice from the following:

Leoš Janáček: Violin Concerto "The Wandering of the Little Soul"*

Antonín Dvořák: Concerto for Violin in A minor, op.53

Bohuslav Martinů: Concerto for Violin and Orchestra No. 2

Performance by heart is not required.

*) Recommended edition: Critical Edition, Supraphon

The organizer will arrange a piano accompaniment after receiving the exact repertoire from the participant. Should the participant have their own piano accompaniment, the organizer provides and covers only accommodation during the participation in the competition.

5. Prizes

1st prize CZK 100,000 **2**nd prize CZK 70,000

The jury can give special awards for the best interpretation of the chosen compositions.

Within two weeks after the deadline participants will be informed whether their application will have been accepted.

- 07. Participants can notify possible changes in repertoire by 20 July 2007.
- 08. Accommodation during the competition is provided and paid by the organizer.
- 09. Transport is arranged and paid by participants themselves.
- 10. In case of late arrival at the competition performance or breaking the rules or status of SLJ, participants will be eliminated from the competition.
- 11. The jury consists of important Czech and foreign artists and experts. Their decisions are obligatory. Results of all rounds will be made public.
- 12. In justified cases prizes do not have to be awarded or will be divided while keeping the order of gained scores of points. In the latter case, the whole amount of money for all prizes will be divided again in proportion to gained scores of points. Prizes can be divided only if completely same scores of points are gained.
- 13. The title "Laureate of Leoš Janáček International Competition", together with diplomas with their names, titles and prizes belong to all prize bearers. Bearers of honourable mention and other prizes and bonuses will also get diplomas without any claim to the title of laureate.
- 14. The organizer reserves the right to record competition performances and the concert of winners. Participants do not have a right to any payment for it. These records must not be commercially used.
- 15. Competition will take place from 3 8 September 2007 in Concert Hall, Faculty of Music of JAMU, Brno. The third round and prize-giving ceremony will take place on 8 September 2007 at 7:30 p.m. in Besední dům, Brno.
